- 1). All committee members and Road Captains will be expected to carry out their duties in full accordance with the descriptions given in the Annual Charter for H.O.G.® Chapters.
- 2). At all times, members should be mindful of their behaviour and actions towards both the Chapter and its members and to consider the potential impact this may have on the Chapter and/or its members.
 - Chelsea & Fulham and Meridian Chapters exist to promote the Chapter and H.O.G.® events and Chapter members are expected to support this in the family orientated, non political philosophy intended in the spirit of H.O.G.® and as set out in the H.O.G.® Chapter Charter.
- 3). It is recognised that Chapter Members may have a membership with other motorcycling organisations. It is not and never will be the intention to restrict any Member from doing so. However, it is expected that all Chapter Members refrain from wearing the insignia from any motorcycle organisation other than H.O.G.® whilst attending a H.O.G.® event as it may conflict with the positioning and display of Chapter Insignia, whether that be a Rocker Cover, H.O.G.® logo or flag or any other Chapter patch, banner or medium. Any Member wishing to participate in a Chapter Event as a representative of a group other than Chelsea & Fulham and Meridian Chapter, must seek prior approval from the Chapter Director, Assistant Director and sponsoring Dealer.
